Aggie Grey's Hotel & Bungalows (Apia)

Coconuts Beach Club Resort (Apia)

Aggie Grey's Lagoon Beach Resort (Apia)



Aggie Grey's Lagoon Beach Resort and Spa is set amongst 50 acres of tropical gardens and is located on a stretch of white sand beach that surrounds a turquoise lagoon. The property is built on the historic site where the first Polynesian migrants landed in Samoa some 2000 years ago.

Tanoa Tuistala Hotel (Apia)

Itinerary

Samoaan Adventures 7 Days / 6 Nights



Day One - Two: Arrive Samoa.

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You will be met at the Falelolo International Airport and transferred to your hotel in Samoa (Upolu – Apia).

Whilst in Apia find time for an excursion; we suggest a visit to the stunning **Falefa Falls** or perhaps go swimming in the **Piula Cave Pool**.

Stay: Aggie Grey's Lagoon Beach Resort

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Day Three - Four: Depart Upolu for Savaii.

You will be transferred from Aggie Grey's Lagoon Beach Resort & Spa to Mulifanua Wharf where you will connect with the ferry to Salelologa Wharf on Savaii Island. Once on beautiful Savaii, you will be collected for a scenic transfer to your hotel.

Northern Tour - Savaii Island

Stay: Le Lagoto Resort

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Day Five - Six: Depart Savaii for Upolu.

You will be transferred from Le Lagoto Resort to Salelologa Wharf where you will meet the ferry to Mulifanua Wharf Upolu. You will then be transferred to to your hotel on Apia (Upolu).

On you last days, relax swim and experience the sights and sounds of Samoa.

Stay: Sinalei Reef Resort

Day Seven: Depart Samoa.

You will be transferred from Sinalei Reef Resort to Falelolo International Airport for your flight home.

Falefa Falls & Piula Cave Pool - Half Day Tour



Drive through the scenic north east coast of Upolu Island, stopping on the way to take photographs of the villages and scenery. Perhaps take a dive off Falefa Falls, which is about 30ft high and drops into the ocean. Then stop off for a refreshing swim on the way back at the Piula Fresh Water Cave Pool. The Cave pool runs underneath the oldest Methodist church in Samoa and is an ideal spot for swimming.

Northern Tour - Savaii Island



On the northern tour of Savaii Island, we visit the colorful Salelologa market, Sapapalii Monument where the first missionaries landed, a Traditional Samoan village meeting house and the 100 year old Saleaula lava field. Then stop off at Satoalepai wetland for a swim with the turtles before enjoying a picnic lunch.

Robert Louis Stevenson Museum Day Tour



The Robert Louis Stevenson Museum is a place where the famous Scottish poet and author fell in love. The Museum is restored using much of the Author's work and family memorabilia.
