Matavai Resort

Anaiki Palms



Anaiki Palms Motel is located 8 min North of Alofi, between Makefu and Tuapa villages. The motel is nestled around several famous sea-tracks and has direct access to the historical Avaiki Caves. According to the local people Anaiki means the 'kings' cave'. Avaiki Caves offers a relaxing, snorkel or reef walking retreat.

Stone Villas

Swim with the Dolphins



Large pods of spinner dolphins are permanent residents and swimming with them is an emotional experience for many.

While the dolphins are free to roam where they like, their habits are reasonably predictable so finding the large pods sometimes requires only a little patience; they can also often be seen giving acrobatic displays just outside the reef.

With the water so clear you can see every detail of these amazing creatures and hear them asking you to play.

Snorkelling Tour - Matapa Chasm



Matapa Chasm is one of the favourite places for locals to go.

The water is refreshing but you swim into the chasm it gets warmer.

Enjoy the amazing clarity of the water and marine life in this idyllic spot.

Whale Watching



If you plan your arrival to Niue with that of the annual Humpback Whale migration you can experience something that very few people in the world can say they have done...swim with the whales. From **July to October** each year Humpback whales arrive in Niue's waters to calve and nurse their young.

Niue is one of only three places in the world where you are able to swim with the whales. For those not so keen on the swim, these gentle giants can be viewed from the land where their gymnastics provide a spectacular show often only 50 metres from shore.
